The conference will be held from 20 – 23 of November 2014 at the University of Cologne. The event is occasioned by the completion of the collected edition of Edith Stein's works (ESGA) after over 10 years of work. The 27 volumes display an impressive intellectual and spiritual panorama of a great saint and scholar.

In honor of this occasion, we would like to extend an invitation to the editors of the different volumes as well as their translators to present the work of this patron saint of Europe. In addition, we would also like to invite other scholars to present their research on Edith Stein's work. Also young scholars are encouraged to apply, since the conference will start on Thursday, November the 20th, with an Edith Stein Colloquium. The colloquium already represents an established tradition and provides young scholars an opportunity to bring their research results up for discussion. The colloquium is followed by the aforementioned scientific conference.
